He earned a master's degree in Counseling Psychology and a bachelor's degree in Sociology from the University of Texas at El Paso.

A graduate of Leadership Chattanooga, Mr. Brice is a member of the Kiwanis Club of Chattanooga and First Centenary United Methodist Church. He and his wife, Jeanne, live in Hixson.
